Assignment 6 – 50 points

Create a 3–5-page document about your proposed project, including the following information:

Project Information – Provide a high-level picture of the project as well as convey the most critical details. Include the following in this section:

- Project Title
- Project Summary
- Project Timeframe
- Project Group Members (1-2 members per group)

Project Summary – Present the reasons for doing this project as well as stating the objectives.

Think about the following questions:

- Why are you doing this project? Money? Fame? Personal interest? Professional interest? Explain.
- What will you be doing? Building a widget? Deploying a webthing? Configuring hardware? Research only?
- How will you be doing it? What resources will you use? Your EUP or AWS VM? Some hardware you have?
- Who will be doing it? What will you be doing, and what will your partner be doing?
- How long do you anticipate the project taking?
- Will there be any costs associated with the project?
- Do you see any risks with completing the project?

Project Deliverables – List out all the deliverables you expect to see after the project is closed. For example, these could be products, information, presentations, or reports that you plan to deliver to a client. Ensure that each deliverable has an associated breakdown of the items included within.

Conclusion – The conclusion sections of this project proposal intend to be a brief conclusion of the project, along with any supporting information. The conclusion is also an acceptable place to put your opinions or outlook on the topics.

Bibliography – Include a separate page for your bibliography, indicating any resources you used to find any of the details within the proposal, or related websites to perform more research on the topic.

Appendix – If there is additional information, such as charts, graphs, images, reports, or other information that were cited in the proposal, it can go into the appendix if it does not naturally fall into the main body of the proposal. The appendix is not necessary, but useful if desired.
